



CONGRATULATIONS to the new Class R! They have all had a great time this week settling in to school, learning new routines, making new friends and responding to the new expectations of school life! We really appreciate all of your support in helping your children to embrace their new adventure!

Next week the children are staying for lunch and will be going home at 1pm. There is a board in the class-room for the children to register what they are having for lunch. Next Week we will continue to learn about the school rules and get used to our new environment. As part of our 'All About Me' topic we will learn about our bodies. We will create skeletons using white straws and learn about the importance of our bones. We will also label the different parts of our bodies and talk about what we can do with our hands, feet, eyes etc. We will be writing our names and recognising, and ordering numbers. We will also count objects carefully by moving them or crossing them out. We will sing songs such as 'Heads, shoulders, knees and toes' and use our bodies to create sounds such as tapping and clicking to accompany music. We will also share the children's memory folders.
