



This week we have been thinking about the four seasons and how we can tell what season we are in. We have focused on the clothes that we wear at different times of the year and the children have used their phonic knowledge to label items. They have also continued to work on their sentence writing. In maths we have been investigating 2d shape. The children are more confident in naming basic shapes and describing their properties. We will move on to naming and recognising shapes with more than 4 sides.

Letters and Sounds We have been revising the digraphs "sh", 'ch' and 'th' and learning how to read the words in phase 3.

Next week we will learning about penguins and writing factual sentences about them. In maths we will focusing on addition.
