We communicate with our families in many different ways and this newsletter is a vital way to share with you things that have happened in school but to also pass on important information. Please, please take a few minutes to read it, particularly dates and important information for forthcoming events.

- The term dates are clearly shown on the newsletter as well as on the school website and if you are ever in any doubt, just call the office or email liz.hall@stminver.org
- The start and end of the school day seems to have become a little too flexible, our school days starts at 8.55am all year round, we have numerous children arriving as late as 9.15am, please can we all have a big push to bring children in on time please.
