

Heatree kit list

Heatree's location on Dartmoor means that the weather can be unpredictable and change quickly, you can often have several seasons in one day! The items listed below are essential

Clothing

One set of outdoor clothing e.g leggings, tracksuit bottoms, long trousers (not jeans), long sleeve t-shirt or t-shirt, sweatshirt

Waterproof jacket and trousers

One warm top e.g. fleece, jumper or hoodie

A second set of clothing for when not on activity sessions e.g jeans/leggings, t-shirt, sweatshirt, hoodie,

Hat, and gloves (scarf optional)

Underwear for two days

Footwear

An old pair of trainers to take part in wet or muddy activities

A second pair of trainers or walking shoes

Wellington boots - these can be provided but sizes and availability are not guaranteed

Slippers or other indoor shoes

Water/beach shoes are NOT appropriate for outdoor activities

Bedding

A single duvet cover (pillows with cases, single duvets and bedsheets are provided) If your child would prefer to use a sleeping bag they can bring that. Long sleeved pyjamas/nightie, hoodie or onesie. (It gets cold at night!)

Other

Lunch box and refillable drinks bottle.

Hand towel and toiletries including a toothbrush and tooth paste.

Medication e.g. asthma inhaler, epi-pens with names on to be handed to Mrs Jones on arrival at school.

Day bag or small rucksack

Please do not bring non-essential electronic devices or any valuables

Optional items

Children can bring a small card game or other game of their choice and a cuddly toy to keep them company at night.

A small torch or night light (battery operated only).

1 packet of sweets/biscuits. Please do not send more there is lots of lovely food available at mealtimes.

A maximum of £10 spending money. There is a gift shop on site that the children will be able to visit on Thursday afternoon. Money to be handed to Mrs Jones in a sealed envelope with child's name and amount written on the front.

Children should come to school dressed in their school hoodie, t-shirt, sporty bottoms, trainers and a waterproof coat.

Please remember to label all clothes and equipment. Also, please remember that the children will be responsible for carrying their bags from the bus to their rooms so they must be able to pick them up by themselves.

Children will be responsible for packing their own bags for the return journey home. Please make sure that they know what is in their bag so that it comes back home to you. We will do our best to ensure nothing is left behind.
