Please note that if they are wearing trainers on OTHER days, these should be completely black. Thank you.

I hope that communicating this to you all now, will ensure that we get on track to be a smart team for the new term, wearing our St Minver uniform with pride! Be brave, be kind, belong!






Stars of the week!
