### Census day lunch

Thursday 6th October will be our termly census day. Miss Martin collects and submits data about the profile of our school that day, as a representative example, which then has future funding implications for us.

It is especially important that all children in Classes R, 1 and 2 are counted for a lunch that day, since we won't get universal lunch funding for the rest of the term for your child if they have a packed lunch on census day, even though you will be entitled to send them for a free lunch any day you wish to.

All infant children will be offered something from the server, but you may want to supplement this with a small packed lunch if preferred.

Thursday's menu—Hot Dog, Chips and Beans or Mac n Cheese, Garlic Bread & Salad!

Your child may be eligible for benefit-related free school meals if you, or the child themselves, meet the eligibility criteria.

If eligible for free school meals, your child will also be eligible for pupil premium. This is additional funding paid to the school to support your child in their learning

We would encourage families of infant children, who are already entitled to a free lunch under the Universal Infant Meals Scheme, to especially consider whether they may be eligible and to apply if so, please.
